PAC Meeting -10/24/11**

- Welcome- Sal Frias

- Lynn Sclossman moved to accept the agenda and the motion was seconded. **Approved**

- Norma moved to approve the minutes from last meeting. **Approved**

- Mr. Frias gave the ASB report: We will have an electronics recycling event at GV on November 12<sup>th</sup>. The sports programs are taking part in a Christmas Tree Fundraiser. Sales will run from October until November 17<sup>th</sup>. Pick up is at Golden Valley on December 3<sup>rd</sup> from 10:00am to 3:00pm. Next month's meeting on November 28<sup>th</sup> will recognize our Students of the Month from October and November, as well as Coaches' Awards for outstanding student athletes.

- Norma gave the DAC report. She gave us information about Kohl's Cares, where Kohl's will send volunteers to help us with any event we choose, along with donating \$500 to PAC. Nissan will be donating a Versa to a 10<sup>th</sup> or 11<sup>th</sup> grader who has qualifying attendance and academic achievement. The solar installations will begin in November. The order of schools is not determined, but all will be completed in April. The property for Castaic High School is in Escrow and undergoing environmental reports. The WISH Foundation has been established to help students in need.

-Mr. Zeevi presented an overview of CADRE, the voluntary, confidential random drug testing as a preventive measure. The administration offices have brochures with information about community services available for students. Mr. Zeevi also gave us information about disaster preparedness and lock-down procedures.
