- Betty Salek moved to accept the agenda and the motion was seconded **Approved**
- Neisha Myers moved to approve the minutes from last meeting **Approved**
- Jennifer Ryan gave the Treasurer's report. We have a total of \$1692.51 in the PAC account. A motion was made by Ami Gonzalez to write a check for \$296 to be distributed to clubs from the Silent Auction at Back-To-School night. **Approved**
- Laura Beers gave the ASB report. October is "Think Pink" month. October 17th-22nd is Homecoming Week. The Football game is Friday the 21st, and the Homecoming Dance is Saturday October 22nd. - The Parent Communication Council meets on the first Wednesday of the month and members were encouraged to attend to report back to the PAC meetings.

- Mr. Frias gave us an overview of our most recent API scores, how they have grown over the years, and at specific areas of growth. There are some areas to focus on that need attention but GV has the highest API score in its history at 773. AP exams have the highest passing percentage since the school opened. CAHSEE scores, SAT/PSAT scores and CELDT scores have all grown since the school started. Last year's senior survey revealed less than 3% of students did not plan to go to college or trade school after graduation. GV continues to make great strides, and MR. Frias will continue to challenge the staff and administration to new heights, and to focus on areas that need improvement.
